


# La Vonne's Knot Just Knits

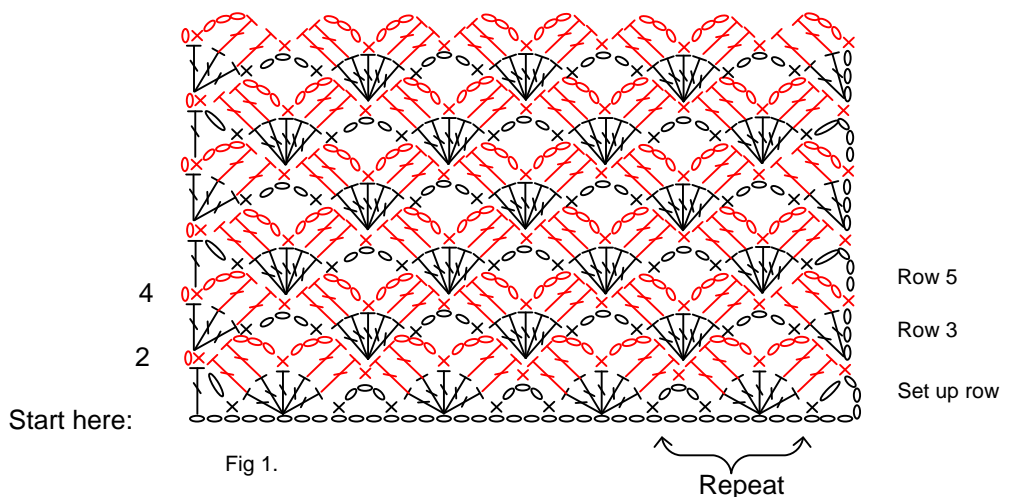
## Cotton Candy Shawligan

Materials: Patons Astra 50g = 133 yds approx (1000, 1100, 1200 yds) 4.5mm/G Hook  
 Size: XS/S, M/L, 1X/2X,  
 Approx measurements: 17(19) 21" X 66 (70) 73"  
 Stitches used: Ch, sc, dc. Gauge: Pat st = Shell, 3 Ch loop, Shell = 4" 7 Pat  
 st rows =4". Note: Piece is worked from center back out.

Stitch Legend	
•	Slip Stitch: sl st
o	Chain: ch
x	Single Crochet: sc
T	Half Double: hdc
T	Double Crochet: dc

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Written Instructions for chart in Fig1.

Set up Row : Sc in 7<sup>th</sup> st from hook, sk 2 sts, work shell in next st, sk 2 sts, sc in next st. \*Ch 3, sk 2 sts, sc in next st. Sk 2 sts, shell in next st, sk 2 sts and sc in next st. \* Repeat from \* to \* until last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, dc in last st.

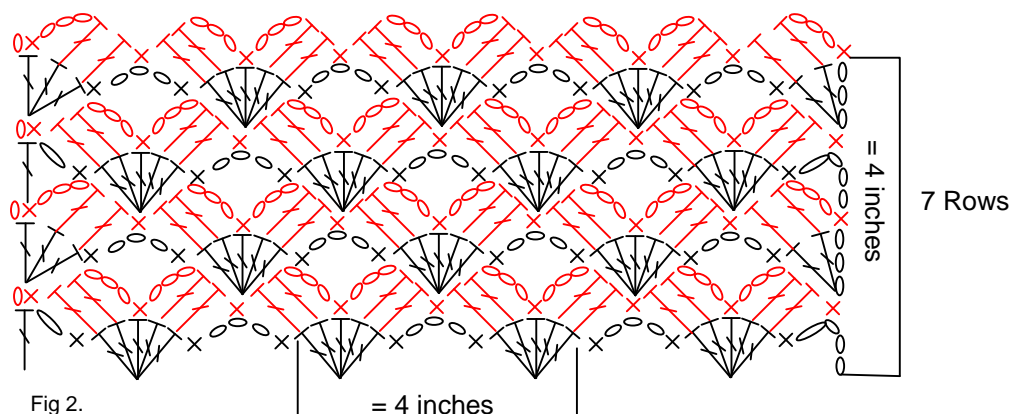
Row 1: Ch 1, sc in top of dc. Work dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, and dc in next 2 dc. \*Sc in next ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc.\* Rep from \* to \* to end of row. Sc in ch 3 loop.

Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop. \*shell in sc, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop\*, Rep from \* to \* to end of row, 3 dc in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in top of dc. \*Ch 3 dc in next 2 dc, sc in ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3 sc in next st.\* Rep from \* to \* to end of row.

Row 4: Ch 4, sc in ch 3 loop, work shell in next sc, sc in next ch 3 loop. \*Ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop, shell in next sc, sc in next ch 3 loop\*. Repeat from \* to \* to end of row, ch 1, dc in last sc.

Repeat rows 2 to 5 for pattern.



How to measure your gauge:

Gauge is measured over the stitches and rows encased in the square brackets as shown in Fig 2.

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**First side:** Starting at center back, ch 78,87,96 and work in established pattern until 11, 15, 19 rows are completed, counting the set up row.

**Armhole opening:** (See figure 3)

**Next row:** Ch 1, sc in top of dc. Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, sc in ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, sc in next st, ch 29 (38) 47, sk the next ch 3 loop and shell 2 (3) 4 times. Sk next ch 3 loop, sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc on next shell. Continue to work rest of row in established pattern.

**Next row:** Ch 4, sc in ch 3 loop, 5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop. Work 5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sk 2 ch sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, sk 2 ch sc in next ch. (Ch 3, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, sk 2 ch, 5 dc in next ch, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch) 2, 3, 4 times. Ch 3, sk first 2dc of next shell sc in next dc. Continue to work rest of row in established pattern.

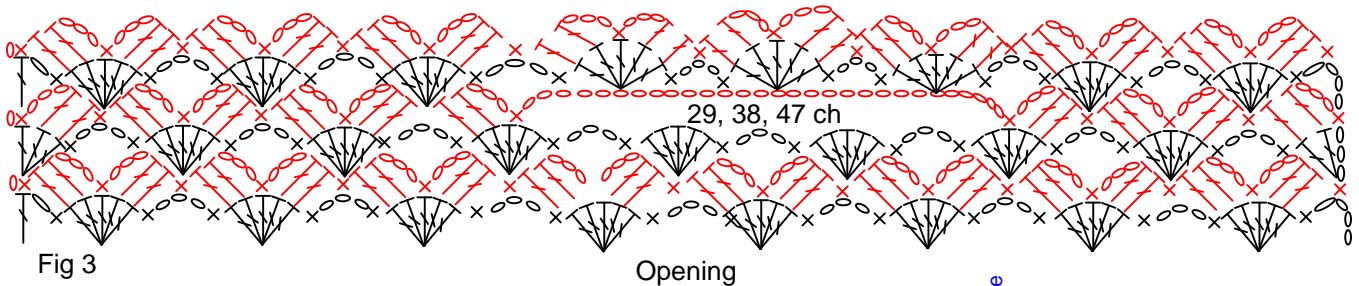

Opening

Continue in established pattern starting with row 2 until approximately 26 (27) 28" or until desired length worked. Fasten off.

**Second side:** Working on the other side of foundation chain, work as for first side. (as shown in Fig 4.)

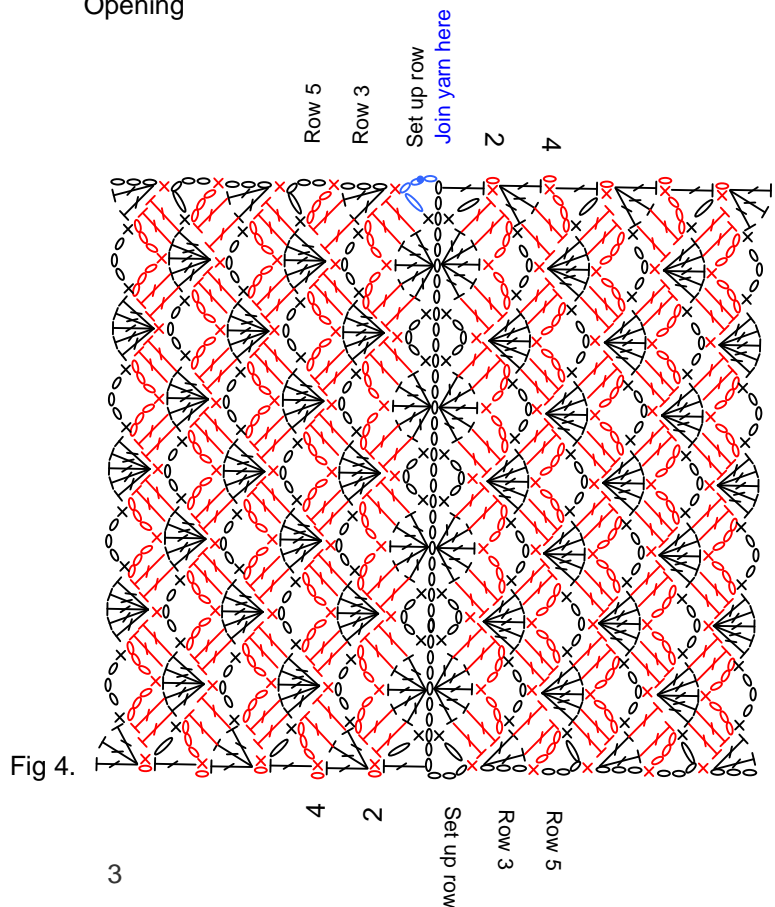

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**Sleeve:** In the symbol diagram below the chain stitches are actually the chain stitches on the opening of the main piece, join the yarn there. Work around the opening, noting the blue symbols are where you join the **rounds** with a slip stitch. The arrow shows where to join your yarn. **Note:** Some rows have a green stitch, showing the last stitch in that row. **Please read the whole sleeve chart before you start for correct placement of stitches. Note the circular arrows at the top of the diagram.** The sleeve shown in the photo is approximately 11"; you may choose to work 18" for the longer version or until desired length.

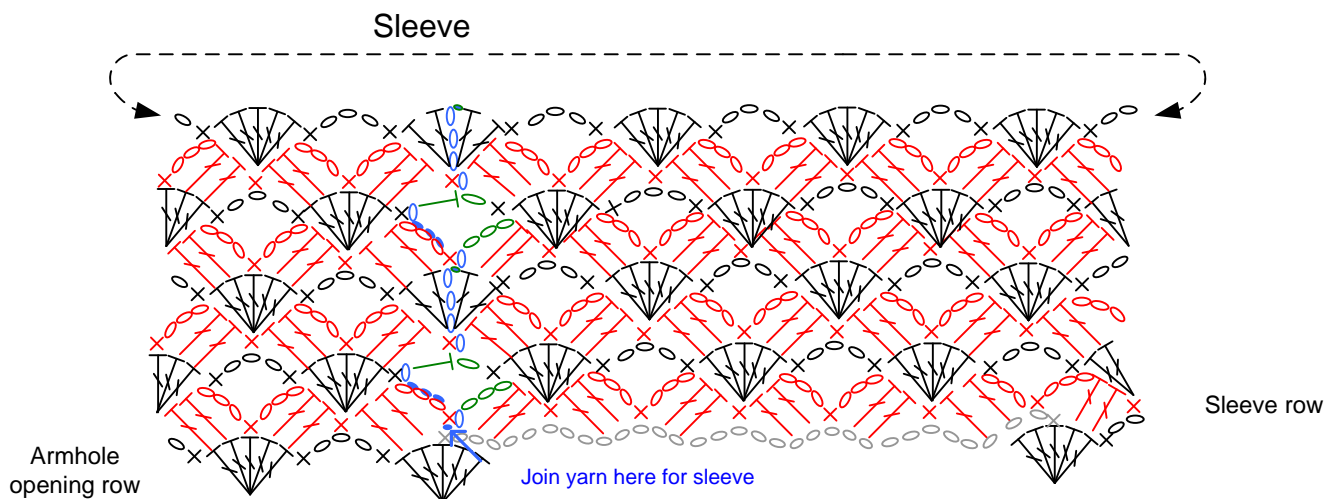

Please note: For purposes of placement and clarification only.  
The stitch counts may not be correct in this diagram

Attach yarn to armhole with non chain edge facing, starting with row 4 of established pattern work as follows:

Round 1: Ch 1 sc in same st as joining. \* Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc. Sc in next ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc.\* Rep from \* to \* to until you come to the chained edge then proceed as follows:  
\*\*Ch 3, sc in next st, ch 3, dc in each of the next 2 sts, sk 2 sts, sc in next st, sk 2 sts, dc in each of the next 2 sts.\*\* Rep from \*\* to \*\* to end of ch sts, Ch 3, sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc to join.

Round 2: Sl st up the 3 ch of round 1, ch 1, sc in same st. Work 5 dc in sc, sc in next ch 3 loop. \* Ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop, 5 dc in sc, sc in next ch 3 loop. \* Rep from \* to \* to end of round. Ch 1, hdc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same st. Work dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, and dc in next 2 dc. \*Sc in next ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc.\* Rep from \* to\* to end of round. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

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Round 4: : Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop. \*5 dc in sc, sc in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 loop, \* Rep from \* to \* to end of row, 2 dc in 1st sc, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in top same st. \*Ch 3 dc in next 2 dc, sc in ch 3 loop, dc in next 2 dc, ch 3 sc in next dc.\* Rep from \* to \* to end of round ending with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Repeat rounds 2 to 5 until desired length then repeat row 2 and fasten off. Enjoy

Repeat for second sleeve.
